Admission Requirements

- Verification of a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution, and a USBE endorsement
- A cumulative minimum GPA of 3.0 or 3.0 for the last 60 credits of university coursework
- 3 professional references who will provide recommendations
- A successful interview with the SOE Graduate Committee
- Submission of complete graduate application

Graduation Requirements

- Complete all program hours with a grade of C- or higher, and overall GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Successfully complete a graduate project that is accepted by the School of Education Graduate Committee
- Complete courses and project requirements within five years
