Suggested Deadlines	Research Task
Sep. 5th	Identify a research question. Please use the "Identify your Research Question" document to guide you through the
Sep. 12 th	 Initial Design of your Study Based on your research question, identify which methodology you will use: qualitative, quantitative, or both.
Sep. 19 th	Fill in the Google Doc with your research question and a short description of your study. (First check in with OTL).
Oct. 3 rd	Complete your CITI training (www.uvu.edu/irb)
Oct. 3rd	Submit your research proposal to the IRB and obtain approval to proceed
October and November	 Finish the draft your literature review section. Disputation study. Think about
November	 Plan your study. Think about: What data will you collect next semester? What instrument will you use? When will you collect your data? Who will collect the data? If you can, conduct a pilot study
3 rd week of Nov.	Present at the OTL Fall SoTL Event. You can present your research project or results from your pilot. This is an opportunity to share your work, exchange ideas with your colleagues, and receive feedback.
Feb. 27 &28	Continue with data collection. Complete the Method section of your manuscript.
Feb. 27 &28	 Analyse your data. Think about How to prepare your data for analysis? (Cleaning) How to transcribe your data? How to code your data? What tools will you use to analyze your data?
Feb. 27 &28	Draft your data analysis and findings section
TBD	Present your SoTL research project at T4L
April (TBD)	Present at UVU 2 nd Symposium on Research in Teaching and Learning.
May 1 st	Submit a research brief to OTL for the SoTL showcase. Write your research article and start looking for journals and conferences for dissemination.
